Ice Rules and Regulations

- 1) Ice fees MUST be paid before stepping on the ice.
- 2) No food, gum, or drink on the ice. No drink containers with a straw are allowed on or near the ice. Only water is allowed near the ice.
- 3) Be courteous at all times. Remember, we are ALL striving to have fun, work hard, and avoid collisions! Always be aware of other skaters around you and respect their rights.
- 4) The skater whose music is playing always has the right of way, safety belts/vest should be worn for visual verification of which skater's music is playing. Second in priority are those skaters who are in a lesson with their coach. All other skaters must yield to these skaters.
- 5) If you should fall, please get up quickly and continue skating.
- 6) No standing and/or visiting on the ice or in the doorway. Remember how much money is being spent for you to skate not talk.
- 7) Appropriate attire for figure skating is required. Please use good judgement. You are all representing the club to rink employees, visitors, and other potential club members who might be watching.
- 8) Warm-up music and personal CD's that are played must be selected in good taste and cannot contain profanity or sexual innuendo.
- 9) The use of personal listening devices such as ear buds and head phones is prohibited.
